Make God Your Priority as Read Through Bible

Jesus said, "My mother and my brethren are these which hear the word of God, and do it." ¹



The *Through-the-Bible in One Year Reading Guide* is a daily reading list of four chapters from eight different sections of the Bible. Not everyone will start this guide on January 1. Just find today's date and start there. In that way, all of us will be reading the same chapters of the Bible together on the same days of the year.

Make God your priority this year. As you set aside times to read through the Bible, make Him your entire focus. Instead of thinking about other things as you read, stop and ask Him to give you new understanding from the Scriptures you are reading. You are not just reading out of duty so that you can say, "I was in the Word today." You are reading for fresh revelation from God.

Instead of thinking about the time, ask God to give you a sense of His timelessness. Enter into His divine rest.

"For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God did from his." ²

As you pray, remember that praying is not primarily asking God to meet your needs or even to meet other people's needs. You are spending time with Him to find out about His needs and His priorities for your life. You don't need anything except His reality.

"God, I want your reality. I want Jesus to be clear to me. I want to become like Him in every thought, word, and deed."

You can't confess yourself into believing something that you are not sure about. You can be sure about God if you spend time with Him.

You don't need a mystical kind of Christianity where you are always guessing about God. You want to know Him and fully understand His ways. You can't live on the hype that you get in a meeting if when you leave He is not reality to you. You want to become so sure about the reality of God that you would die for what He has shown you.

Fasting Takes You Closer to God

“Gather my saints together unto me; those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice.”³

This year, set aside times for fasting and prayer. Fasting helps you to experience a deeper relationship with God. It is an example of the death-life principle—dying to self for the sake of the kingdom. You don’t give your lusts any rights. You forbid your body to have preeminence.

In our ministry, we begin the year with a 21-day fast and also fast in some way every week. Email us for a booklet on the Isaiah 58 fast that brings light, healing, protection, and answered prayer.

“If you do these things, your salvation will come like the dawn. Yes, your healing will come quickly. Your godliness will lead you forward, and the glory of the LORD will protect you from behind. Then when you call, the LORD will answer.

‘Yes, I am here,’ he will quickly reply.”⁴

When you make a commitment not to eat, whether it is one meal, one day, or one week or 40 days, and you make it through, you gain a satisfying sense of accomplishment in addition to any results you see from your prayers. Especially when you go on an extended fast, you become full of faith for what God can do for you supernaturally.

Jesus said, “When you fast . . .”⁵ (not “if you fast”) because He expected His disciples to fast. He fasted for 40 days, and we know that the number 40 represents testing.

Fasting breaks through your inner turmoil and clarifies what you believe and what you should do. The devil likes to mess with your mind and he hates to see Christians fasting because fasting breaks every yoke.

Fasting is God’s age old prescription for breaking bondages. It is not optional for Christians. The work of deliverance that Jesus has called us to do is too important to neglect this spiritual discipline that will empower us. God is calling us to fast, and we must obey.

Fasting takes you above your circumstances and your needs into the realm of eternity where God is.

The Bible contains 1,189 chapters (Old Testament, 929 chapters; New Testament, 260 chapters). Reading 4 chapters per day, and repeating Proverbs and the End Times books of Daniel and Revelation, a person can read every chapter in the entire Bible in 12 months.

READ ONE CHAPTER FROM FOUR SECTIONS OF THE BIBLE EVERY DAY. COMPLETE THE ENTIRE BIBLE IN ONE YEAR!

Pentateuch. Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy.

History. Joshua, Judges, Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Samuel, 1 Kings, 2 Kings, Ezra, Nehemiah, Esther. (1 and 2 Chronicles are read at the end of the Epistles.)

Poetry. Job, Psalms, Song of Solomon. (Ecclesiastes is read at the end of the Prophets.)

Wisdom. Proverbs (*repeated during the year*)

Prophets. Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, Malachi. (Isaiah is read after the Gospels and Acts.)

Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke, John. Followed by Acts and Isaiah.

Epistles. Romans, 1 Corinthians, 2 Corinthians, Galatians, Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians, 1 Thessalonians, 2 Thessalonians, 1 Timothy, 2 Timothy, Titus, Philemon, Followed by 1 and 2 Chronicles.

End Times. Daniel, Revelation (*repeated during the year*)

This month as you read Genesis 12 and 13, notice the Lord's call upon Abram (Abraham), the man we now call a patriarch. The Lord identified Himself with Abraham's earthly lineage when He said, "I am the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob." Those were people whom He called out of darkness. They didn't have the light of His reality until God made Himself known to them. That is true for every one of us. The Bible says that we grope at noon day. We know that there is a God but we don't know God unless He reveals Himself to us. Abram didn't have a Bible to read, so God changed him until his life became the Bible that we read. As you seek to know Jesus Christ through the Word and prayer, live in such a way that when people read your life, it fills their hearts with faith.

This month you will read in Numbers 13 how all the spies but Joshua and Caleb saw themselves as grasshoppers compared to the inhabitants of the land. I'm out of here." Jesus isn't backing off anything. In Christ there are no chumps. You are anointed. God has nobody else to work with but you. You're the one.

There was no “separation of church and state,” because they understood that only godly people were fit to govern.

“Every person who shall be chosen a member of either house, or appointed to any office or place of trust, before taking his seat, or entering upon the execution of his office, shall take the following oath, or affirmation . . . ‘I, A.B. do profess faith in God the Father, and in Jesus Christ His only Son, and in the Holy Ghost, one God, blessed for evermore; and I do acknowledge the holy scriptures of the Old and New Testament to be given by divine inspiration.’”
